2004 Nigeria, West Africa Excavated cellar and diverted fire to control well using existing tree

2003 South Ramallah, Iraq. Well Control Specialist on oil well fires during Operation Iraqi Freedom. Provided well control & firefighting services during control of oil fires and well kill operations as a result of damage during armed hostilities.

1999 Colombia - worked on damage to 3 wells caused by guerillas

1999 Offshore Louisiana - Production Platform well blowout and fire, cleared debris while burning, extinguished fire, capped well and killed it.
