### **HIGHLIGHTS OF WELL CONTROL EXPERIENCE**

2004 Kirkuk, Iraq- Capped large gas well on fire in extremely hostile area of country.

2003 Iraq- Team leader, Project: Restore Iraqi Oil April 2003-January 2004

2003 Controlled/killed large blowout in rural Venezuela that broached surface around four different wells with a footprint covering 20-plus acres.

2001 Kuwait-Controlled and killed only HT/HP gas well with snubbing unit.B.H.P. 20,000 p.s.i.

2001 Elk Hills, California-Skid rig and capped large gas well blowout in one day.

2001 Brookshire, Texas-Removed rig from crated well. Tied well back to surface, fished pipe and killed well through slim hole conditions

2000 Nigeria-Capped and killed production well under hostile conditions

2000 Algeria-Controlled and killed largest gas well (240mmcf) in remote Sahara Desert. This well was capped on fire and killed from bottom.

2000 Chambers Co., Texas-Gas well blowout, skid rig, remove B.O.P.'s, cap well and supervise snubbing and kill.

1999 Lost Hills, California-Capped largest gas well in California near aqueduct with minimal environmental impact. Well controlled in 17 days

1999 Eastern Venezuela-Controlled two large blowouts.

1998 Saudi Arabia-Controlled 2 large gas well fires in the remote area of the country.

1998 California-Gas fire capped and diverted. Supervised snubbing operations.

1998 Cameroon, Africa-Supervised snubbing operations to P & A six gas wells in highly populated areas
