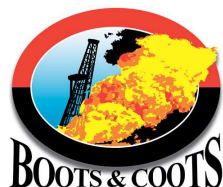

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| 2007 | Argentina - Controlled gas well blowout in rural South Argentina in 2 days. |
| 2006 | Nigeria - Team Leader. Controlled oil well fire in hostile region of the Niger Delta. Also worked in conjunction with third party security team responsible for all personnel safety. |
| 2005-2006 | Gulf of Mexico - Performed extensive well repairs and multiple platform salvage projects created by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. |
| 2004-2005 | Kirkuk, Iraq - Project Manager and Team Leader. Capped and controlled 6 large oil wells sabotaged in the Kabbas Field in Northern Iraq during extremely hostile conditions. Hazards varied from H ₂ S gas, daily security incidents to capping wells on fire. Also worked in conjunction with the security team responsible for all personnel safety. |

- 1997 Alaska - Supervised fabrication of firefighting equipment necessary for Arctic conditions.

- 1995 India - Controlled large gas blowout and fire on well making in excess of 500 million cubic feet per day.
