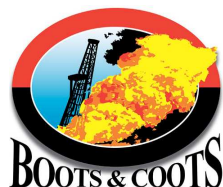

HIGHLIGHTS OF WELL CONTROL EXPERIENCE

1964-Present	Most experienced firefighter in the world (over 800 jobs).
1995	India - Led IWC team that controlled massive blowout within 17 days.
1991	Kuwait - Led one of the first well control and damage assessment teams to site.
1988	North Sea - One of the first two men aboard the industry's worst disaster - Piper Alpha. Responsible for killing 36 wells of which 12 were burning.
1983	Hungary - Capped and controlled thermal blowout. First American team invited into the Eastern Block country.
1980	Mexico - Controlled land fire that produced 68,000 barrels and 125 million cubic feet of gas per day.
1979	Iraq - Controlled fire on well producing 100,000 bbls per day.
1978	Persian Gulf - Controlled blowout producing 900 million cubic feet per day from a conventional derrick barge.
1971	Bay Marchand - controlled multi-well platform. Russia - Killed well producing 85,000 barrels per day with 23% H ₂ S and 60% CO ₂ .
